The Cara Cara was first discovered in 1976 at the Hacienda de Cara Cara in Venezuela. Today they grow in California's San Joaquin Valley with a peak season between December and April.

Cara Cara oranges are a cross between two navel oranges. On the outside, they look just like an orange but on the inside, they are a beautiful reddish-pink. They are known as "The Power Orange®" because of their low acidity and excellent nutritional value.
