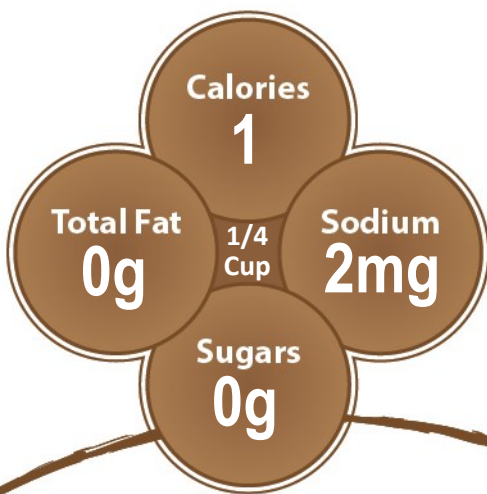


Harvest of the Month

FUN FACTS:

The leaves of the plant are the herb “cilantro.”
The seeds of the plant are the spice “coriander.”

Fresh cilantro leaves have a short shelf life after being cut from the plant. Their aroma is completely lost when dried or frozen.

Cilantro, sometimes called ‘Mexican parsley’ or ‘Chinese parsley’, is commonly used in Latin American and Asian dishes.

Cilantro and coriander are very different in flavor; they cannot be used as a substitute for each other.
